



## **LEAF end of financial year report – 2023 – 24**

### **Year overview**

It has been a successful year for LEAF, with us having raised money for the benefit of all children at Leechpool Primary School.

The 2023-24 financial year started with a balance of £47,729.84 and the financial year closed with a balance of £50,493.99.

### **Fundraising**

Our fayres, discos, music gala and film nights continue to be a huge success with us raising profits of £12,662.93 from these events alone. We moved the date of our May Fayre this year and held the fayre as a summer fayre after school. This proved to be a success. We have been trialling improvements to our cashless payments and are looking to roll out QR codes to every stool by our next May/Summer Fayre.

We continue to receive commission from Taylor Made Uniforms, having raised £841.00 this financial year. We have also raised funds through "Easy Fundraising" and commission from the Christmas Card sales.

We have continued to support many charities throughout the year, including Children in Need, Comic Relief, Horsham Matters, St Catherines Hospice to name a few. The charities the school are currently supporting and the amounts raised are [here](#) on our website.
