Since the outcome of the Ofsted Inspection the Governors and the Leadership Team of the school have been busy addressing the issues of the report. On Friday 22 November 2024 the Local Authority Advisory Team visited the school to evaluate the progress the school is making. The report from this visit stated that no evidence of unacceptable behaviour had been seen. That attendance issues with families are being addressed and that significant progress has been made on ensuring that the curriculum is being implemented consistently. The Governing body has completed training to ensure that they are carry out their statutory duties. The report stated that the school has clearly identified key areas for improvements. The school will provide a further update by the end of term of all the actions that have been taken over the last term to address the findings from the Ofsted report.

Lost Property


